Lincolnshire has approximately 5,500 miles of roads, 1,800 bridges and 3,000 culverts serving a population of in excess of 700,000, demanding a robust maintenance and improvement program delivered through this framework of the County's highway network.

In each case, these contracts have been successfully completed on time and within budget.

A particular feature of these contracts is the use of the failed tar bound material - which is recycled into a foam mix base before being re-laid as a environmentally sound, cost effective, high performance base layer.
